



Sixth Form Learning Agreement 2024/25

You have made a commitment to continue your education in the Sixth Form at Arnold Hill Spencer Academy. This involves obligations for both the Academy and for you.

A copy of this agreement will be signed during the formal course registration process.

Courses

The Academy promises to provide the courses agreed at the start of the year and advise on appropriate public examinations. Where a student's courses do not work out successfully, the Academy will try to find an alternative course where possible.

Progress and Achievement

The Academy will support students' learning, progress and well-being throughout your course, helping with career choices and applications for employment or continuing education. The Academy will inform students of target grades and other expected outcomes.

Entrance Exams

In some subjects, students may be asked to take an entrance test in September. If the academy has concerns regarding these entrance test results and the progress you will make, the Academy will at their discretion ask you to move to an alternative course.

Personal Development, Tutor time and Enrichment

Students are required to attend Tutor time lessons. Tutors will write supportive UCAS, and employment references and we will provide opportunities outside the classroom to aid student development and enrich their experience of Sixth Form life.

Attendance and Behaviour

The student promises to abide by the guidelines for students set out in the student information provided, including aspects of attendance, dress, conduct and the acceptable use of information technology. The student will complete all work to the best of his/her ability and, where appropriate, by the given deadlines. He/she will seek help from teachers, tutors or other members of staff when facing difficulty.

Disciplinary Action

In the event that the student does not abide by the guidelines set out, or where attendance is unacceptable there is likely to be disciplinary action. With repeated cases of poor attendance, behaviour or where there has been serious misconduct the student may be asked to leave the Sixth Form.
