Being organised

Homework

- ▶ Homework is set regularly, and students should expect to do some homework every week.
- ▶ This can be both paper format or electronically.
- ▶ Parents/carers will be signed up to get reminders about homework.



PE Day

On a PE/Dance day, students are to attend in full school uniform; students will get changed for PE and will need to remember all kit.

You will know these days when your child receives their timetable at the start of the new term.

Students do not need kit on their first day in September



Break and lunch areas

- ▶ Year 7 area is in B Block
- ▶ Snackchat is a large dining room with plenty of space to sit indoors
- ▶ There are lots of toilets and facilities nearby
- ▶ Multi use games courts, and a football court are solely for year 7
 - students will be shown this
- ▶ Active play and outdoor learning is a priority of Mr Simpson's next year and the school will be investing in activities and resources for the Year 7 play areas
- ▶ Year 7 will go to lunch slightly earlier in September than the rest of school for a few weeks

SnackChat and Keeping Hydrated

- ▶ Year 7 students have access to Snackchat for lunchtime
- ▶ Packed lunch or purchased lunch can be eaten in Snackchat
- ▶ A range of hot food and sandwiches are available to purchase

A refillable bottle is essential, and we have lots of water fountains for them to fill up at



Cashless Catering

- ▶ Students will have biometric scanning on their first morning in September
- ▶ Parents/carers can top up accounts via SCOPAY
- ▶ Arnold Hill Spencer Academy does issue lunch tokens if a student is without money on a rare occasion, but the amount is to be repaid via SCOPAY as soon as possible, and students will not be issued lunch tokens repeatedly

Chance behaviour system

- ▶ Positives- all staff will be using **Synergy** to reward positive behaviour, especially those who show **respect** for others.
- ▶ C1 Verbal Warning - Behaviour needs to be corrected
- ▶ C2 Restorative conversation outside of classroom
- ▶ C3 15 min correction
- ▶ C4 On-call - Refocus room for the remainder of the period and a 45-minute correction will be set

Extra - Curricular Activities

- ▶ We have a whole host of extra-curricular events at Arnold Hill Spencer Academy
- ▶ Tutors will advertise what clubs and events are happening each half term.

5. Leave calmly as directed

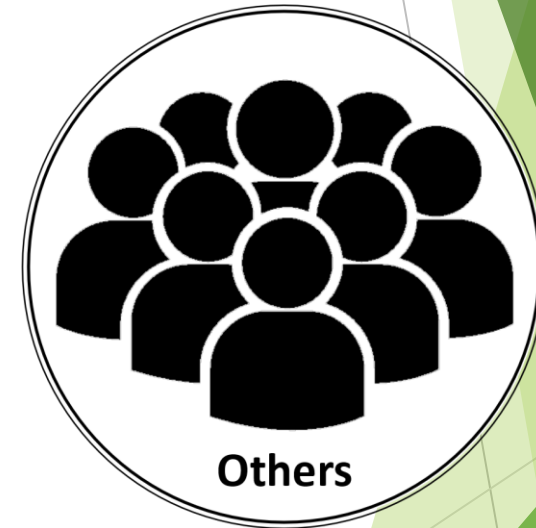
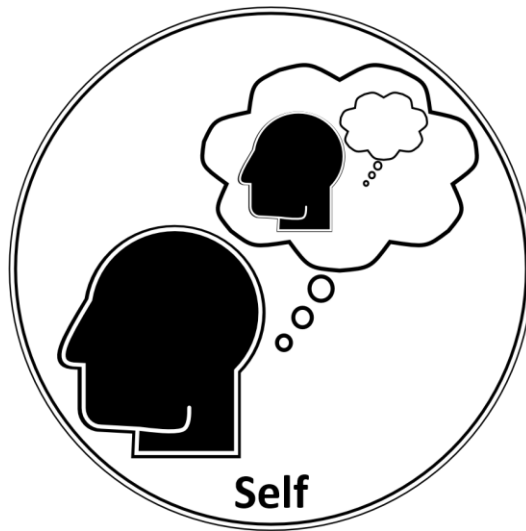

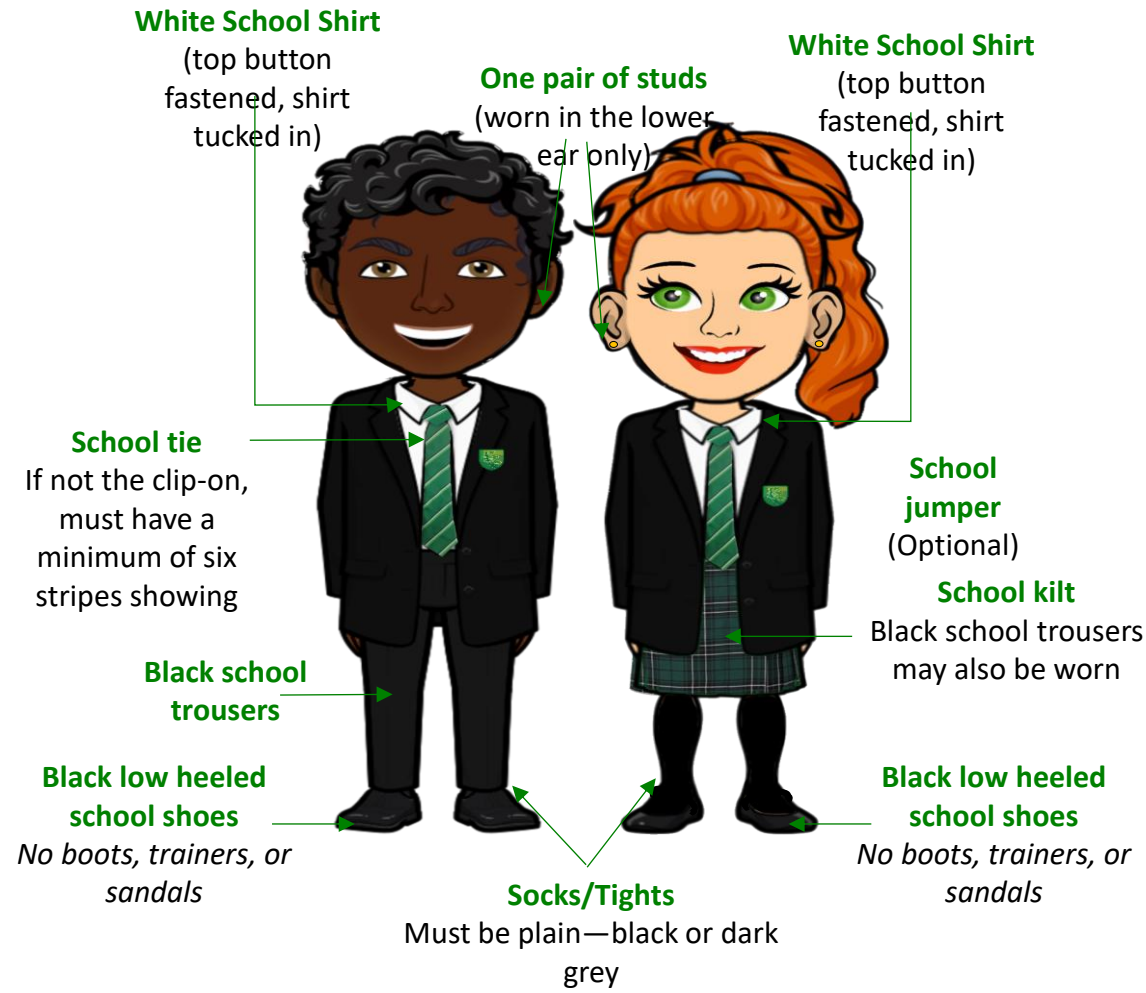


Learning & Behaviour Habits

Uniform
